Important info about Attendance from September.

The Gates & Doors will open at 8.40am and close at 8.55am. Once the doors are closed you will need to bring your child to the office and sign them in. Your child will receive a L (Late) code from 8.55-9.15am. If your child arrives after 9.15am they will receive a U code until pm registration. Please be aware that U codes are classed as unauthorized absences and may be counted towards a Fixed Penalty Notice.

If you receive 10 or more U (Late After Register Closes) & or O (Unauthorised Absence) codes you may be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice.

If your child is marked late you may receive a late text.

If we don't hear from you after trying to make contact we will leave your child's mark as no reason. This will be left until the following Monday where the mark will be changed to O code which will not be changed back once the mark has been changed.

Please make sure you call and leave a message with the office before 8.55am.

Please be advised teachers will not be permitted to change codes for illness and all illness or medical issues need to be reported to the School Office.

If after no contact we will make home visits if necessary and contact the police to complete a safe and welfare check on the family home, especially to our vulnerable families.

If school have reason to believe you have taken a family holiday and reported this as an illness further advise will be sought from our education welfare officer.
