It's your chance to say "Thank You" to Father Lameck for his service to you and the community.

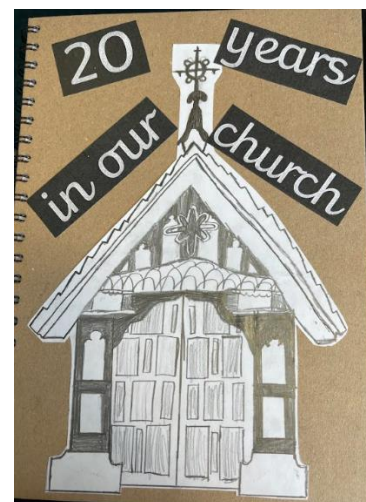
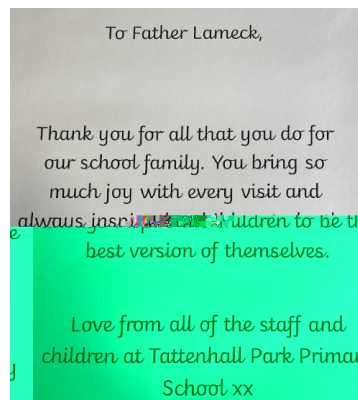
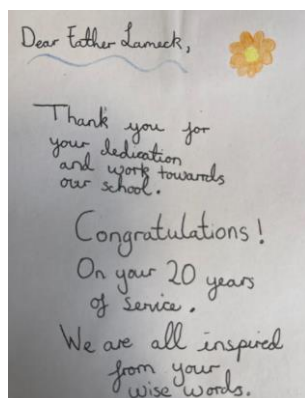
