



# TATTENHALL PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL

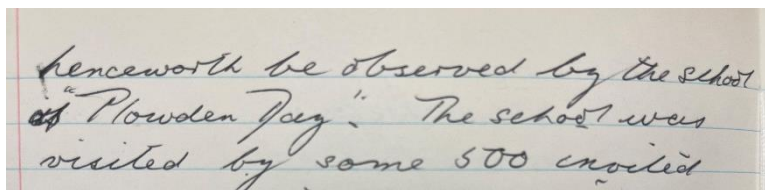
Dear Tattenhall Park families,
